Dear Presenters,

Thank you for being part of INTERACT 2026.

To ensure smooth and standardized presentations, please follow the guidelines below.

1.Presentation Time

- 1. Total time: 10 minutes
- 2.8 minutes for presentation
- 3.2 minutes for Q&A session from judges or audience
- 4. Please manage your slides to fit within the time limit.
- 5.Presenters may use English or their national language as long as the content remains academic, educational, and professional.

2. Slide Preparation

- 1. Maximum: 8 slides only (excluding title slide)
- 2. File format: PowerPoint (.pptx) or PDF presentation
- 3. Aspect ratio: 16:9 widescreen
- 4. Font type: Arial / Calibri / Open Sans (legible, professional fonts)
- 5. Font size: Minimum 20 pt for body text
- 6. Avoid excessive text use keywords, visuals, and graphs

3. Slide Structure (Suggested 8-Slide Allocation)

- 1. Title of presentation, presenter's name, school/institution, and logo(s).
- 2. Introduction / Background : Describe the issue, context, or inspiration for your project or research.
- 3. Objectives / Aims : State clear and measurable objectives. Use bullet points (3-5 max).
- 4. Methodology / Approach :Explain what methods, tools, or strategies were used. Include visuals or flowcharts.
- 5. Results / Findings : Present data, key outcomes, or evidence of success. Use graphs or images.
- 6. Discussion / Impact : Explain how your work benefits students, schools, or communities. Relate to SDGs or innovation goals.
- 7. Reflection / Future Plans : Summarize lessons learned and possible next steps. Keep it inspiring.
- 8. Acknowledgment & References: Thank contributors, schools, or institutions. Include short references if needed.

4. Presentation Tips

- 1. Be confident, concise, and stay within time.
- 2. Maintain academic and professional tone.
- 3. Use visuals
- 4. Rehearse beforehand to ensure smooth transitions.
- 5. Bring a backup copy on a USB drive or email.

5. Submission & Technical Notes

- 1. Submit slides to the conference secretariat 10 day before presentation.
- 2. Use the file naming format:

- 4. Check projector compatibility and video playback in advance.
- 5. Avoid heavy animations or online links (use offline files).


